The **Miami Youth Leadership Initiative (MYLI)** is a training and support program offered by Miami Youth for Christ and Impact 922 Ministries. MYLI is designed to introduce a model of youth ministry that focuses on the effective evangelism, discipleship and empowerment of young people.

Participants will create step-by-step, practical strategies for reaching un-churched, non-Christian young people with the Gospel; discipling them to become fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ, and empowering them as leaders.

The program includes bi-weekly training classes, and a system for implementation and accountability of the program. We ask participants to be committed to regular trainings, and a willingness to implement the model of ministry being taught. Although we want to introduce ministry ideas that may be new to you and your ministry, we are committed to ensuring that the ministry model being taught is compatible with the vision and mission of your church / ministry. Participants can opt to continue in the program for 2 consecutive years.

Participants will be asked to turn in monthly ministry reports, gauging how they are doing in the ministry, and be open to meet with the MYLI Director to discuss plans for implementation of the model.

Minimum Criteria for Candidate

The following selection criteria will be minimum requirements for applicants. They must:

- Be in serving in youth ministry
- Be in a position of leadership -- can implement plans for change. (Volunteers are also accepted into the program).
- Be a learner -- open to change
- Demonstrate a willingness to be held accountable for the principles being taught (one-to-one meetings and ministry reports will be required)
- Be willing to complete a limited amount of outside readings and a few assignments.

About the MYLI Director -- Tommy Carrington brings over 30 years of youth ministry experience to the initiative. He earned his M.A. in Counseling / Psychology from Trinity International University, and Doctor of Ministry from Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary, specializing in "Ministry in Complex Urban Settings." He also serves as an adjunct professor at Trinity International University and Palm Beach Atlantic University.
